

Page 209: Ezra II: 8 - 28

While studying page 209, I have hardly found letters that I could clearly identify. I doubt whether Castiglione was in a better position. After all, he published his reading of this page 24 years after the publication of page 210. Moreover, he did not incorporate it into his own supplements, the latest appeared in 1839, but rather have it published by someone else. I suggest that his reading is, for the most part, a reconstruction, meticulously and skilfully done.

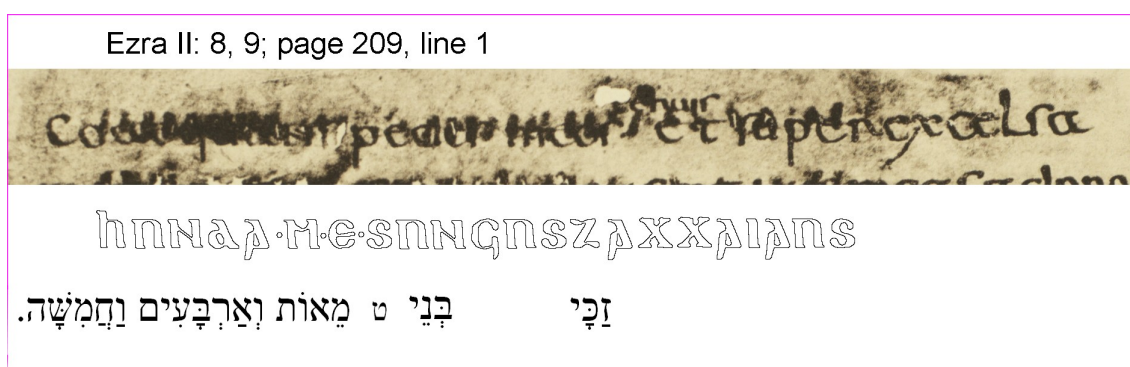


Figure 4.1. Page 209, line 1

Ezra 2: (8) hundred forty and five. 9 The children of Zaccai,

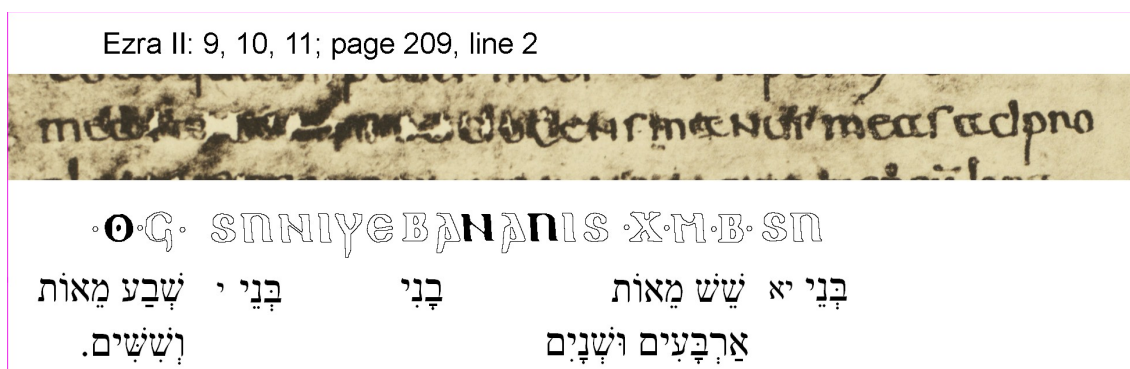


Figure 4.2. Page 209, line 2

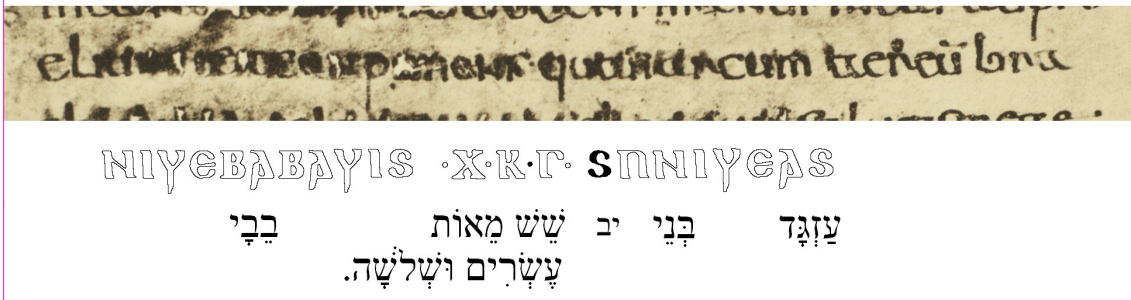


Figure 4.3. Page 209, line 3

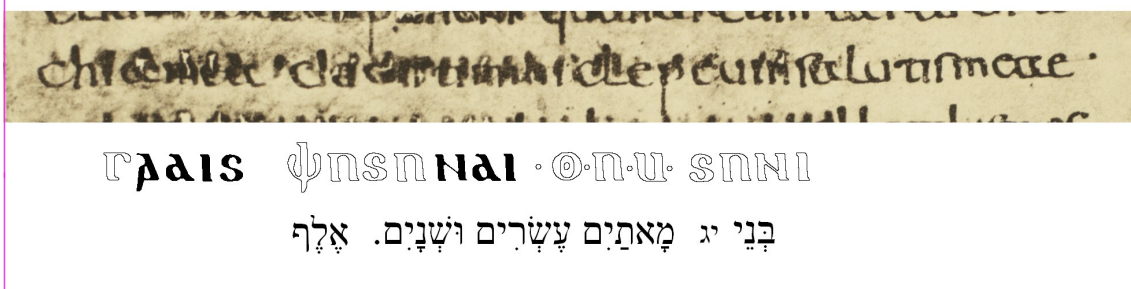


Figure 4.4. Page 209, line 4

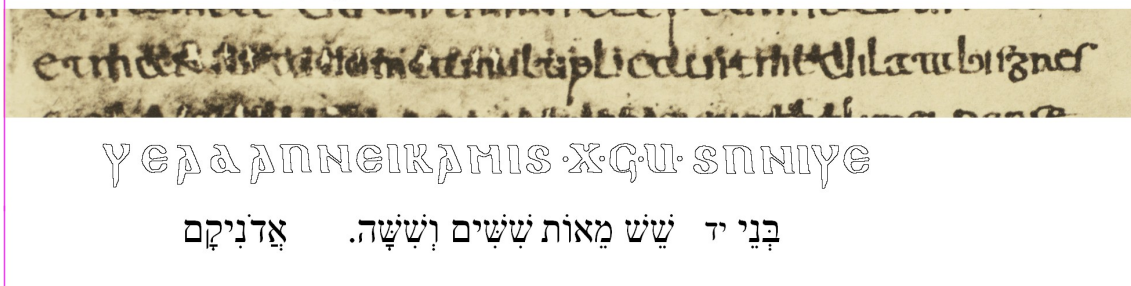


Figure 4.5.. Page 209, line 5

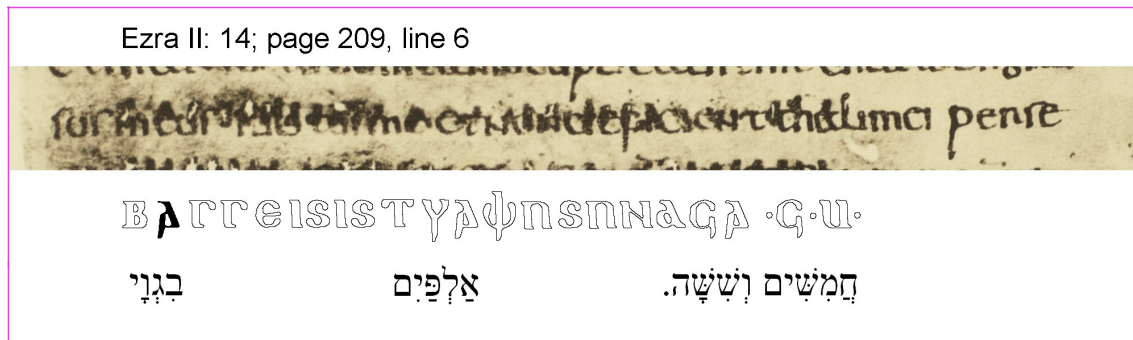


Figure 4.6. Page 209, line 6

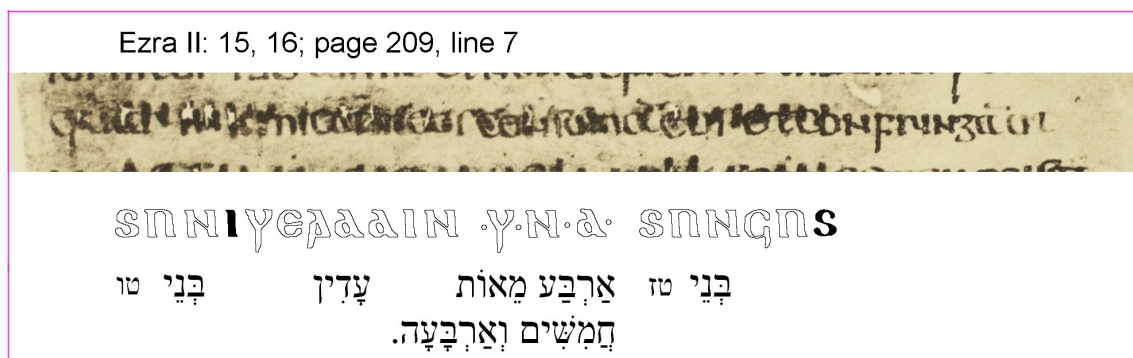
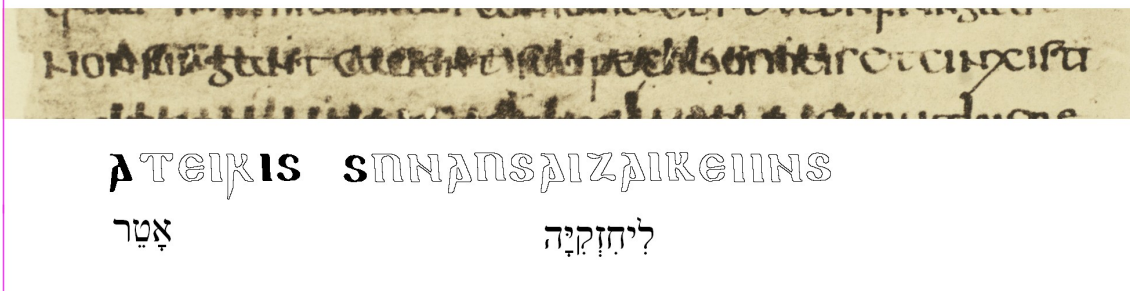


Figure 4.7. Page 209, line 7

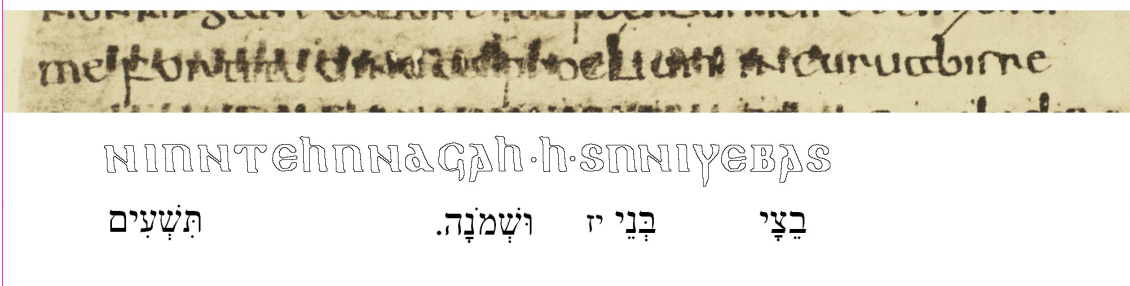

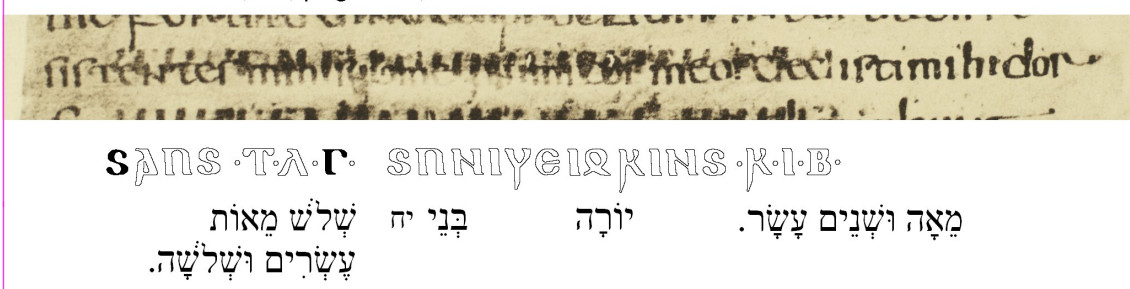

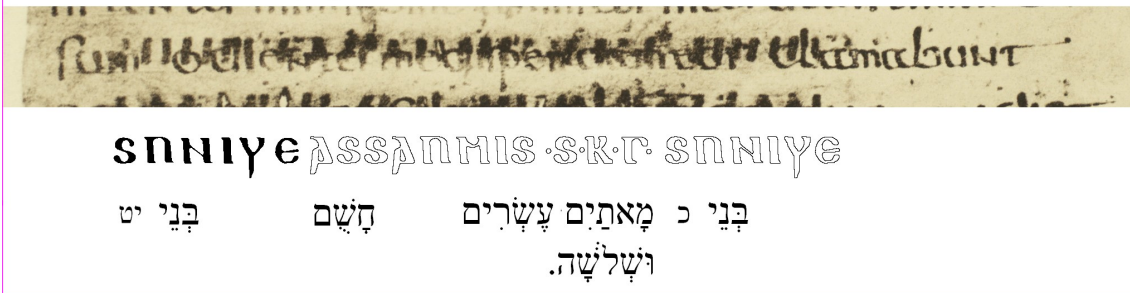


Figure 4.11. Page 209, line11

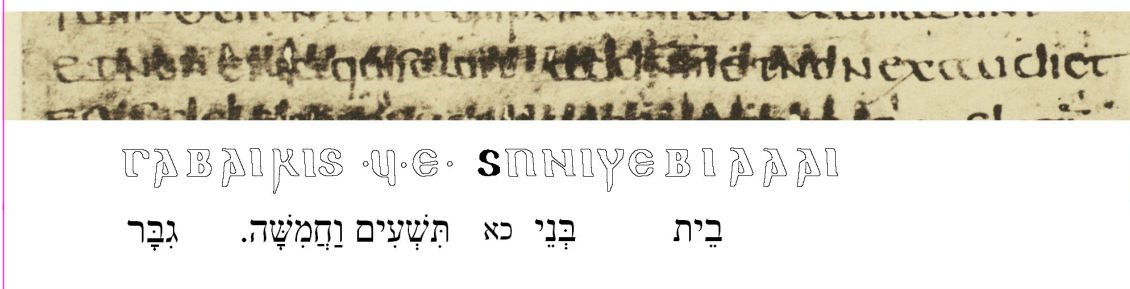


Figure 4.12. Page 209, line12

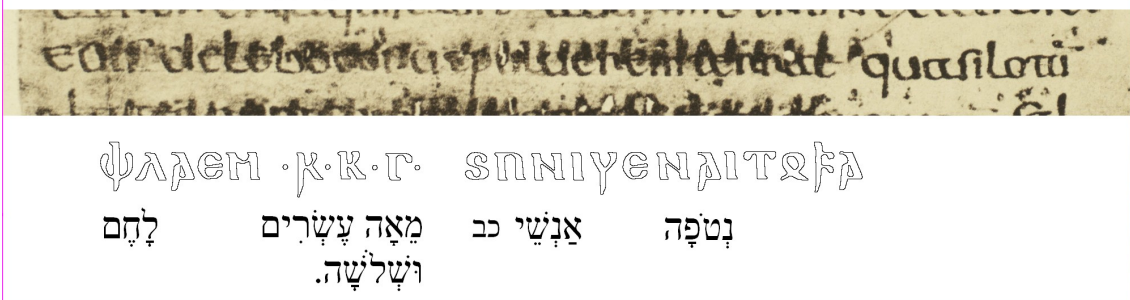


Figure 4.13. P. 209, line13

Ezra 2 (21) an hundred twenty and three. 22: The men of Netophah,

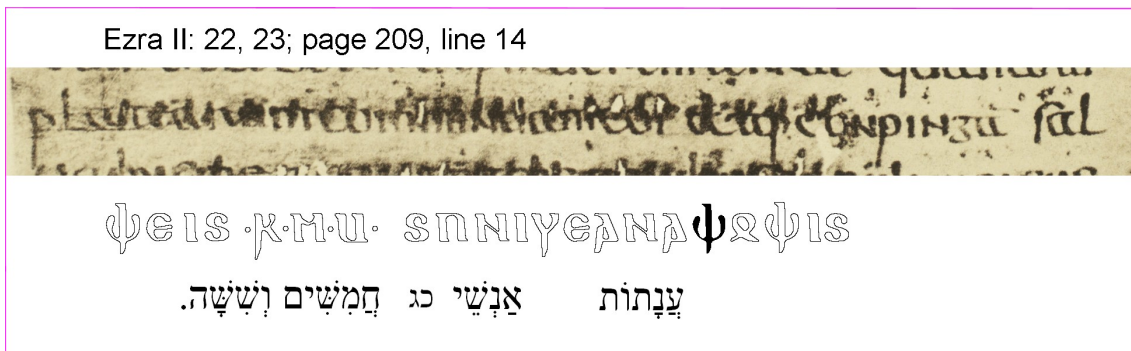


Figure 4.14. Page 209, line14

Castiglione marked 146 returnee of Netophah, against Ezra's 56.

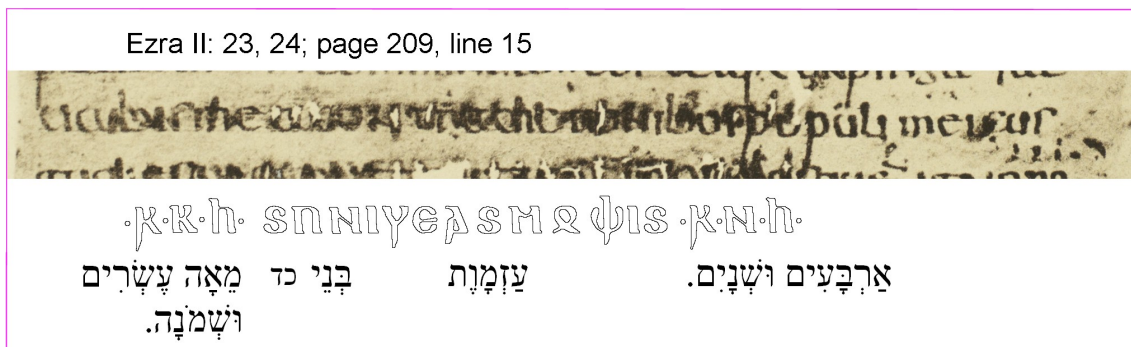


Figure 4.15. Page 209, line15

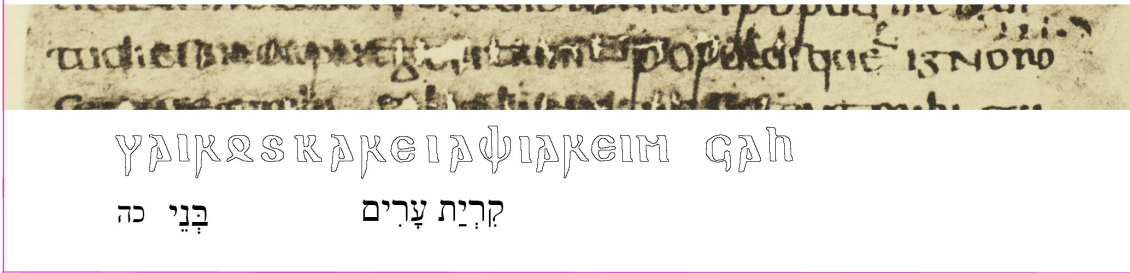


Figure 4.16. Page 209, line16

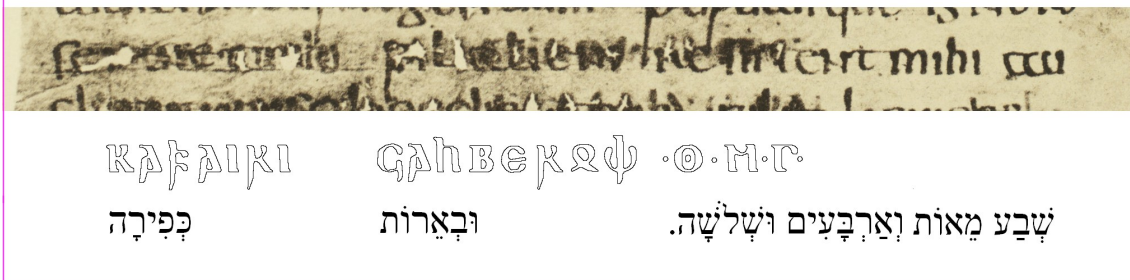


Figure 4.17. Page 209, line17

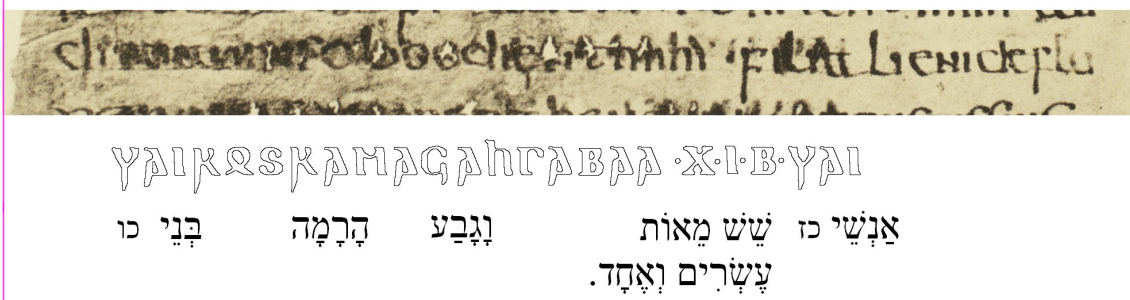


Figure 4.18. Page 209, line18

Castiglione read a different number, 612, than Ezra, 621.

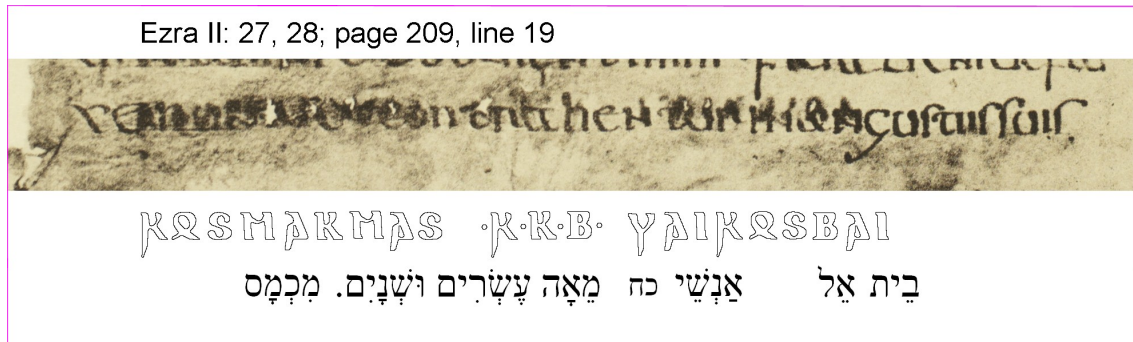


Figure 4.19. Page 209, line19
