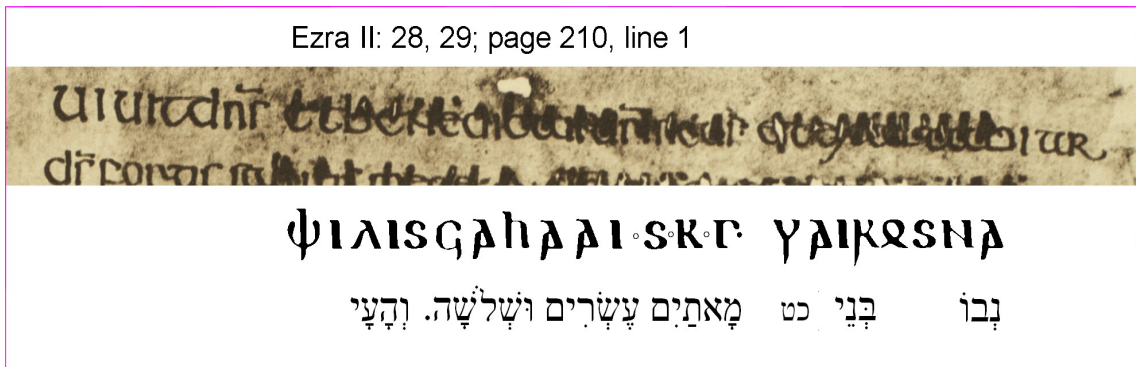


Figure 3.1. Page 210, line 1

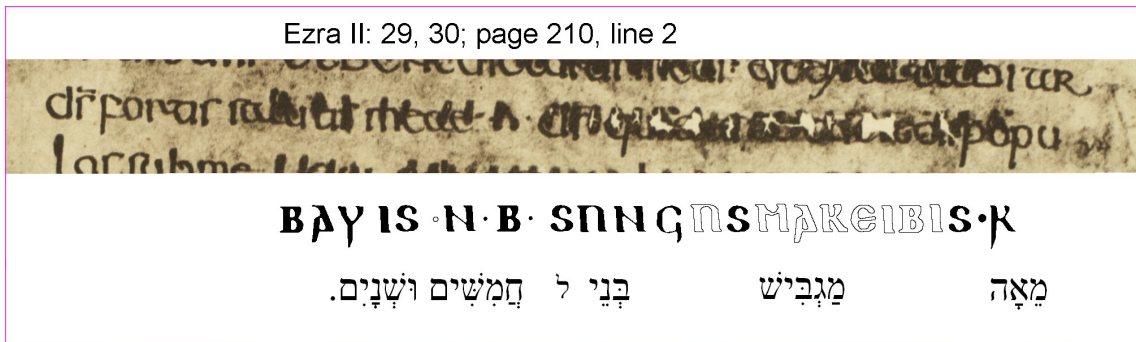


Figure 3.2. Page 210, line 2

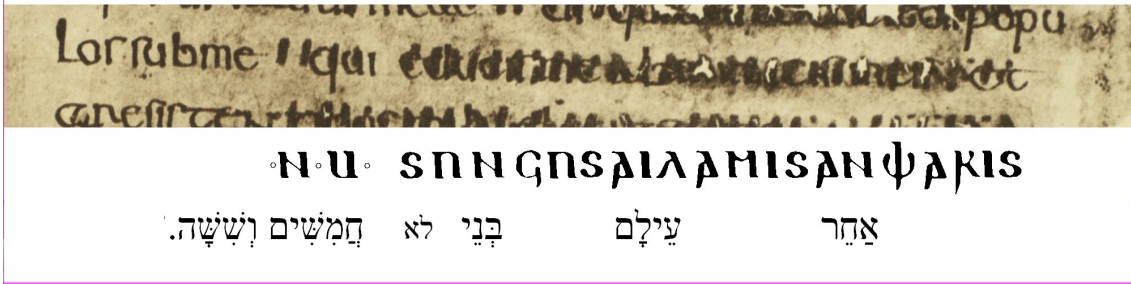


Figure 3.3. Page 210, line 3

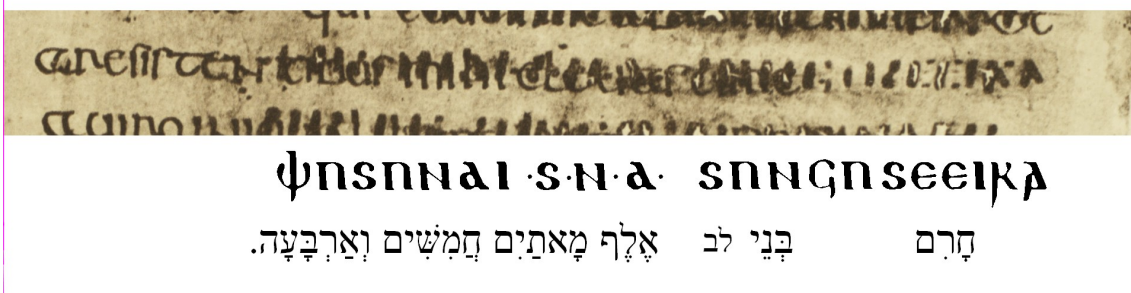
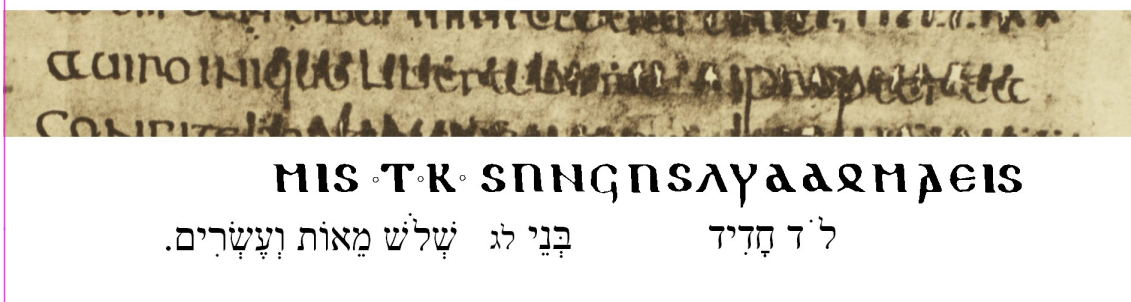


Figure 3.4. Page 210, line 4

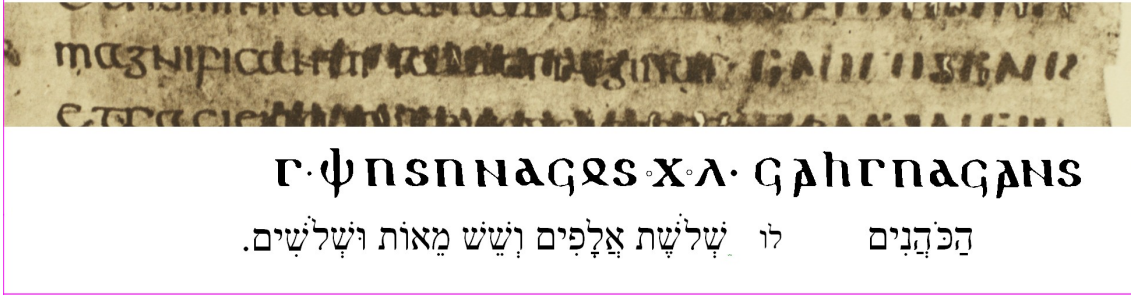


Figure 3.8. Page 210, line 8

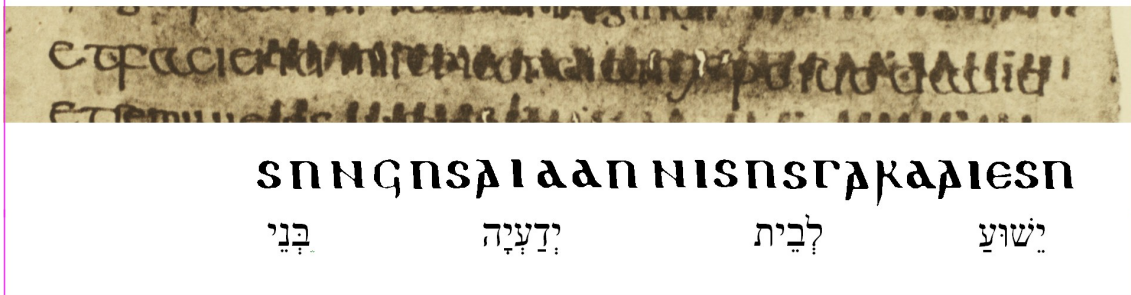
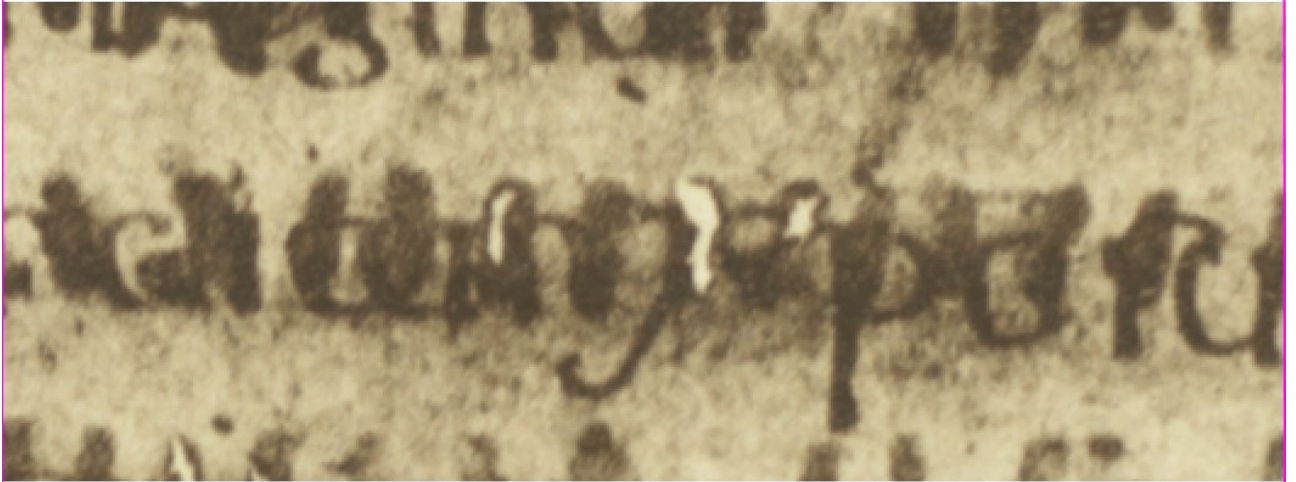


Figure 3.9. Page 210, line 9

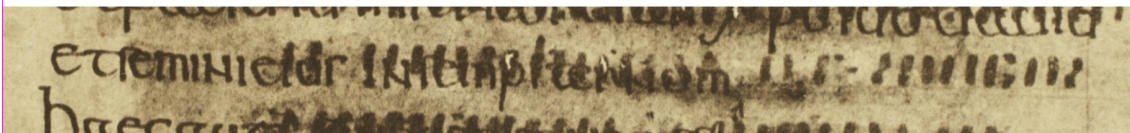

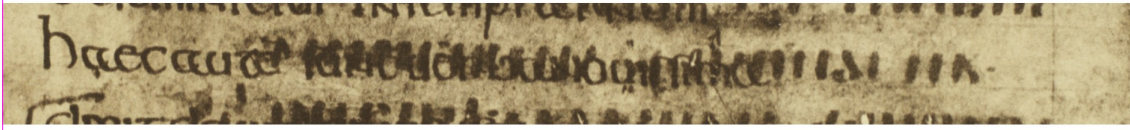

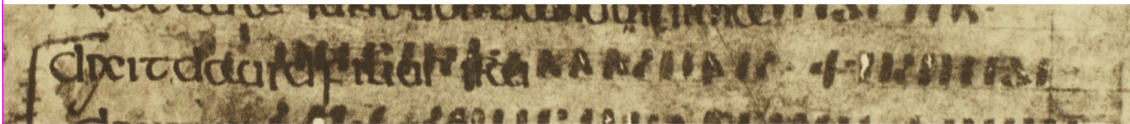

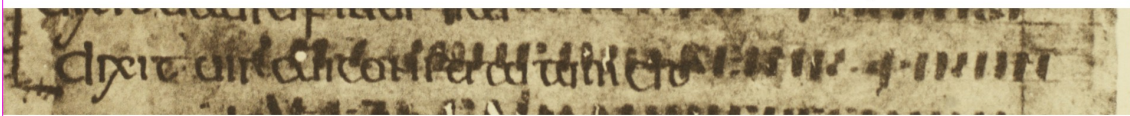

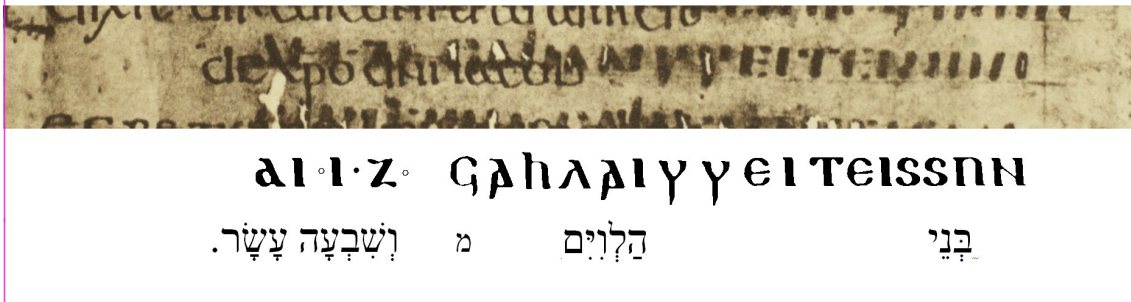


Figure 3.15. Page 210, line 14

In the Masoretic text of Ezra 2: 39 it is written “the children of Harim, a thousand and seventeen.” In the Septuagint 2 Esdras 2: 39 we read: “sons of Herem one thousand seven.” In the Gothic manuscript (P. 210, lines 13, 14) the number is clearly 1017, as in the Masoretic text.

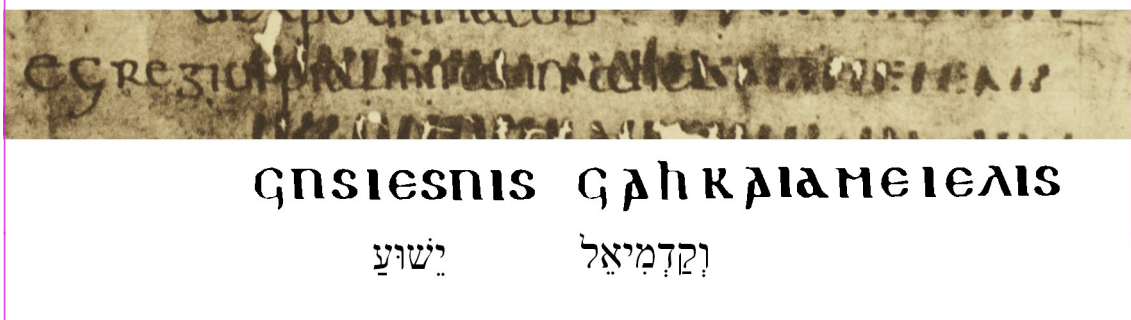


Figure 3.16. Page 210, line 15

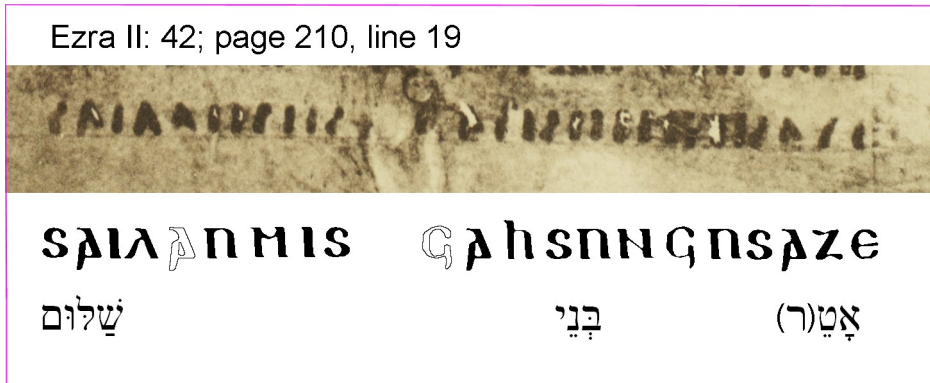


Figure 3.20. P. 210, line 19
